Children celebrated Chinese New Year by trying some Chinese cuisine and also trying their hand at some Chinese writing whilst in the forest!

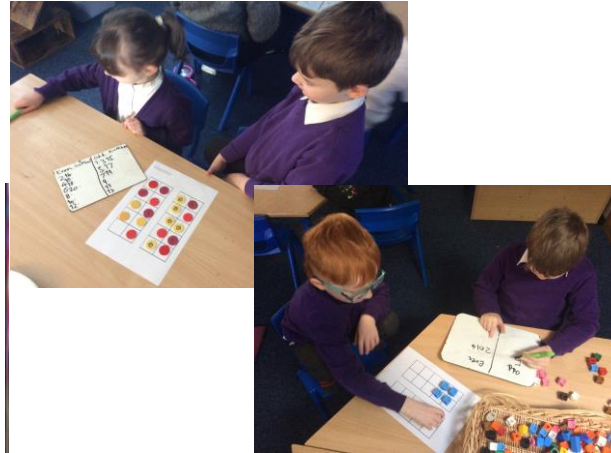


Aiming High

Spring 2 in Year 1 and 2

We have had a fantastic half term in Year 1 and 2!

In Art this half term we have been exploring printing using inspiration from Paul Klee and Kandinsky. We can name the 3 primary colours and the 3 secondary colours and have experimented making these in our prints.



In Fluency Bee, we have been investigating odd and even numbers and doubles using the pair-wise pattern.

In Science we have been learning about everyday materials. We have looked at a variety of objects and the materials they are made from. We have learned how we can describe materials using their properties and we have also carried out investigations to test materials to see whether they were absorbent, transparent or opaque.



Aiming High

Spring 2 in Year 3 and 4

We explored different forces in Science and really enjoyed creating a structure to protect our egg from a fall! We used our knowledge of gravity and air resistance to help us with our designs.



PE this term has been dance. The children have used their knowledge of rhythm, synchronicity and teamwork to create some beautiful sequences taking inspiration from Matilda the musical!

In Art, we explored printing looking at the work of Damien Hirst. The children really enjoyed exploring the different prints a variety of materials could make.
